

HIGH SEAS STOP MARION ISLE LANDING

PRETORIA, Wednesday.

The S.A.N.F. frigate Transvaal which left Durban early last week and arrived at Marion Island on Sunday afternoon, has so far, according to the latest signal received at General Headquarters in Pretoria, been unable to discharge her cargo because of unusually rough seas.

A member of the shore party, Sergt. Juid, who was standing on a cliff on Monday, lost his footing and fell into the icy sea when watching the frigate. One of the frigate's small boats which was attempting to land rescued him.
