THE ROCKHOPPER PENGUIN CHICKS STARTED TO MOLT OUT OF THEIR DOWN COATS, AND THEY TOO WILL SOON BE LEAVING US. WE WISH THEM WELL. COLON HAS ADOPTED A PINK KING PENGUIN CHICK AT ARCHWAY BEACH, AND PROVIDES A DETAILED REPORT ON HIS HEALTH AND STATUS WITHIN THE COLONY AT THE SLUGHTEST PROMPTING.
