RE FATHER OF ARTHUR M. GEORGE

With reference to your minute of the 26th instant to Arthur M. George of this city I have to state that he has given me the following particulars:-

His father, David George, was born in St Helena, is now about 50 years of age and is presently resident in that Island, his mother and the rest of the family consisting of two sons and a daughter being in Port Elizabeth.

His father was a general dealer and mineral water factor in St Helena but he has now given up his business and is desirous of joining the remainder of his family here where employment will be found for him.

The two sons are employed at Messrs Mosenthal's Dept and the daughter is an assistant in a Jeweller's shop, whilst two uncles are employed at Messrs Willet's Chemist store.

There are also other relatives in various parts of the Union.

The eldest son now seeks permission for his father to join the family here.
