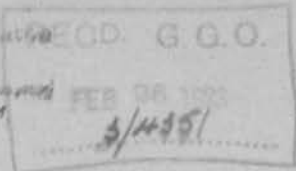

MINISTERS have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of His Royal Highness the Governor-General's Minute No. 3/4343 of the 30th February, on the subject of the supply of timber from Government sources at Cape Town for the construction of cottages on the Island of Tristan da Cunha.
