MINISTERS have the honour to inform the State President that the Consultative Parties to the Antarctic Treaty, including the Republic of South Africa, recommended at their Ninth Meeting in London on 7 October 1977 that a definitive regime for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources should be concluded.

MINISTERS have the honour further to state that the first session of a Special Consultative Meeting of Parties to the Treaty was convened in Canberra, Australia, between 27 February and 16 March 1978 for this purpose and that in the course of further negotiations between the Parties a draft text of a Convention for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources was provisionally agreed.

MINISTERS have the honour to recommend that it may please the State

President to approve the appointment of the following persons to

represent the Government of the Republic of South Africa at a Diplomatic

Conference of the Consultative Parties to the Antarctic Treaty in

Canberra, Australia, between 7 and 21 May 1980 to which certain interested

governments and international organisations have also been invited as

observers and at which the text of the convention for the conservation

of marine living resources will be considered and adopted.
