 Tristan da Cunha.

With reference to your minute No. P.2B1/6/1/3 of 13th April, 1946, (ex Cape Town) I am directed to convey the Commission's recommendation for the grant to three unmarried members of the staff of the Divisions of Meteorology and Civil Aviation who will be stationed at Tristan da Cunha, of the privileges of free furnished quarters, rations, fuel and light and the issue to them of protective clothing (oil skins, rubber sea boots, etc.) as departmental equipment to be replaced only when condemned as unfit for further use. It is noted that these benefits are valued as follows:

Rations	£50 per annum
Furnished quarters, fuel and light	36 per annum
Protective clothing	10 per annum

The Commission is not prepared to recommend the grant of the abovementioned privileges in lieu of the cost of living allowance payable in the Union, but considers that cost of living allowance should also be paid to the officer concerned at half the normal rates i.e. on the basis set out in paragraph 7(iii) of Treasury Circular No. 14 of 1940. I recommend accordingly. The privileges are not of a pensionable nature.

Attention is invited to the terms of Treasury Circular No. 18 of 1939 and Treasury Circular Minute No. F. 28/398 of 27th October, 1939.
