

# Past breeding success predicts current success




8-20% of males are cuckolded;





# Changes in average threat status







1970s: 2000 cats killed 450,000 petrels per year




20 years since cats eradicated;

increase in burrowing petrels



# Skua trends at the Prince Edward Islands










