I have always been under the impression that they left with the Agulhas. I am not able to tell, but I assume then that the ship that does not appear to be military, is the Agulhas, so I have labeled that folder as "There" and those on the military ship "And Back". Also note that the guys look more excited on the Agulhas and there are sheep on the ship, which I expect would have been on the "There" journey rather that "back".

From the Naval Fraternity Facebook Page, it seems that the military ship was either the Transvaal or the Natal.

In some of the photographs of the passing Shackleton, the bomb doors are open which means it probably did a mail drop? In one of the photos, the yellow "J" is visible above the extended radome, making it Pelican 16, no 1716, the remains of which is now in the Sahara.
