1985). Very high ammonia and urea concentrations of 16.69 mmol.m⁻³ and 2.89 mmol.m⁻³, respectively, (Fig 6a, b) were found off the penguin colonies in the near-shore area.

From these results it is evident that freshwater run-off from the islands enhances the amount of reduced nitrogen in the immediate vicinity of the Prince Edward Islands, with possibly important biological implications.

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
